

WHEN HE APPEARS



The Song of Solomon is one of the loveliest works in the Old Testament, and is unquestionably the most intimate. Although it is a simple love story between a king and his bride, Bible scholars and laymen alike have had difficulty with it.

Ron Auch brings an insightful approach to the Song of Solomon, first showing it as a historically accurate account of Solomon and his bride by carefully comparing it to other scriptures that relate to Solomon's life. Then, the Song of Solomon is shown as a spiritually accurate allegory of Christ (the king) and the Church (His bride).

The bride is faltering in her marital relationship because of a lack of obedience and intimacy, a self-imposed separation from the groom, selfishness, and the stains of worldly desire. Christ is returning for His bride, but will the bride be ready When He Appears?

#### **Calvary Café**

Our coffee bar, Calvary Café, opens this week. Everything is still complimentary, so just ask the volunteer for whatever it is you would like and they will be happy to help. We have three flavors of coffee plus decaf, chips, juice, water, soda, crackers, and baked goods. If this is something you would like to help with, please let pastor Jason know.

Also, in order to preserve the spirit of worship, Calvary Café will be closed once the worship portion of service ends. It will reopen once the teaching has concluded.

#### Food in the Sanctuary

Just a reminder to everyone to please refrain from bringing food and drink into the sanctuary with the exception of water. It really helps with minimizing distractions during service and helps to keep the room clean. Please enjoy refreshments in the foyer and/or the Parlor.

#### **Event Sign-Up Stations**

You have probably seen the clipboard collection we develop at the welcome desk for all the events throughout the church. As you can imagine that becomes quite a crowded place on Sunday mornings.

So, to better serve the church, in the near future we will be installing two computer kiosks where the coffee used to be. These will be touch-screen stations where you can sign up for the different events in the church. The great thing about it is, we can open things earlier for sign up, we can reduce the congestion at the welcome desk, and we can include more events.

If you have any questions about how to use these, staff will be able to assist you, however it will not be difficult at all.

#### Maintenance

Over the past year we have made the intentional move away from a full-time maintenance person to relying on volunteers, and it has gone very well. We currently have a number of people help with cleaning, vehicle and equipment care, grounds keeping, and other needs.

Even so, we are in need of a person to come in a couple times per week and check on things that don't normally get checked (i.e. the roof, drains, water softeners, etc.). That is why the decision was made to bring Glen Moyer on staff for about 8-10 hours per week to do these very things.

If you have been helping with the property, please continue – we still need you! Glen is not taking over the property, he is checking on the out of the way stuff that gets overlooked or forgotten about.

They develop partnerships with missionaries in the field, recruits missionaries, and sends out short-term teams. It was while working here that David and Lee gained a desire to see the people of Morocco reached with the message of Jesus.



church members. At times, it seems like they are mainly interested in miracles, supernatural manifestations and "prosperity" more than the Giver Himself. Lastly, pray that God will draw those who are in the peripheral of the church family into a vibrant relationship with Him."
