MARCH MISSIONS Vision Project

Al's Heartwarming Center Shelter in Pottstown, PA, is our vision project for the month of March.

A program of Pottstown Living in Faith Together (LIFT)

Privately funded shelter for men and women.

Works with local churches, agencies, and organizations to provide individuals with needed care for mental health, substance addition, physical, spiritual, and emotional issues.

Has served over 130 individuals over the past year, with 27 beds for overnight rest.

Plans to increase capacity to 36 beds this year.

Support goes to fund administrative costs, staff, heating, electricity, and transportation to those in need.
