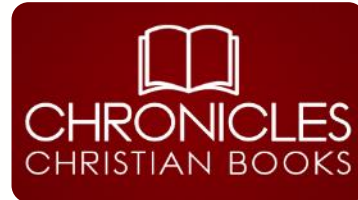

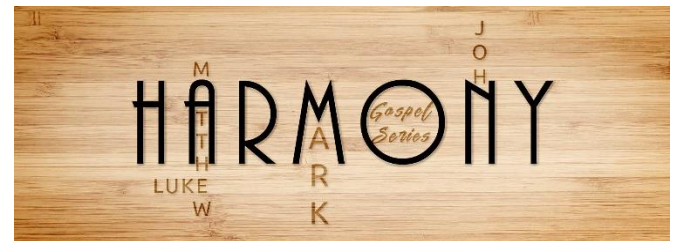

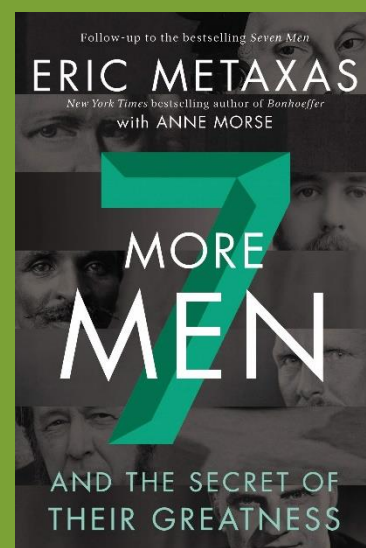

## MAY MISSIONS Vision Project

**Issachar Imperative** is our Missions Vision Project for the month of May.

The Issachar Imperative organization helps equip people of faith with a Biblical Worldview. This is done through monthly meetings, the yearly Worldview Institute, and through other educational events and articles.

The goal is “to understand the prevailing world views that exist in our culture by analyzing headline events on a weekly basis and discussing their implications. We ask what world view is behind the actions of each event and what would be the appropriate Biblical World View of the same event? And then we ask ourselves, “What should we do?” It’s simple, but stretching, enlightening and motivating.”

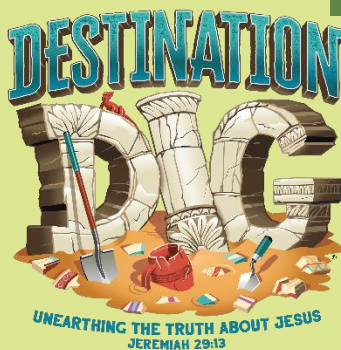
Every second Sunday at 12:15 PM we offer a membership class for those wishing to join our congregation.
