
THE SCREWTAPE LETTERS

JUNE MISSIONS Vision Project



The United Methodist University in Liberia, Africa, is our Missions Vision Project for the month of June.

The United Methodist University is a private institution of higher learning located in the West African nation of Liberia. Established in 1998 and opened in 2000, the school has over 5000 students enrolled on four campuses across Liberia.

The vision/goal of the University is to prepare a new generation of men and women schooled on the African continent to build nations that are spiritually, socially, economically, and politically independent and self-sustaining.

Due to the University’s support for traditional Christian Values, they have lost the support of the United Methodist Church Denomination and are facing the potential loss of their building. Please be in prayer and consider supporting the university during this difficult time.
