


Fear. Rejection. Addiction. Anger. Comfort...Must Fall.

Pastor Derrick Whitmore is the founder and currently serves as the Executive Director of Shattered Studios, a non-profit organization that shares hope and faith through the creative, performance, and media arts.

Derrick felt the call to ministry after the Lord healed him of the depression and low self-esteem he felt as a youth. While serving as the youth pastor of Shepherd of the Hills, Derrick observed some of the youth were dealing with similar levels of depression and even suicidal thoughts. He felt the urgent need to gather a team together to specifically address this need and soon Shattered Studios was formed. Not long after, Derrick felt God calling to devote more time into working with those struggling with depression and, as a result, he began

working for Shattered Studios full time. Due to the large amount of missionary resources available in Orlando, FL, he decided to expand Shattered Studios to incorporate the Orlando metro-region.

His greatest desire is to help people, especially youth and young adults, come to personally know the Lord and grow in an unending relationship with Him. Derrick is also passionate about inspiring others to use whatever gifts they have been given to serve others and glorify the Lord (1 Peter 4:10-11).

Angel Tree – Prison Fellowship is our Missions Vision Project for the month of November.

Angel Tree, a program of Prison Fellowship, reaches out to the children of inmates and their families with the love of Christ.

This unique program gives your church an opportunity to share Christ's love by helping to meet the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of the families of prisoners.

Angel Tree runs programs throughout the entire year, including Angel Tree Christmas, Angel Tree Camping: a summer camp program with partner churches, and Angel Tree Sports Clinic where children hear the Gospel and receive life lessons from top-tier athletes.
